Completed applications must be received by July 31, 2019. Applications received after the deadline will not be considered

- To qualify for this scholarship, a student must be accepted into a postsecondary institution (college or university) program in fall of 2019, that could include any of these disciplines: agriculture, mental health, food, nutrition, culinary arts, agricultural commerce or marketing, veterinary, horticulture or food service.
- The applicant must be family of an NSFA member or sponsored by a NSFA member.
- Unsuccessful applicants may re-apply in the following year(s) as long as you are still eligible.
- No individual will be eligible for a second award.
- Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- The scholarship will be available to **full time** students studying (or accepted) at an accredited college or university within Canada.
- The scholarship will be presented at the Niagara South Federation of Agriculture AGM.

In addition to filling out the application, the following information is required:

- A copy of your latest transcript. (Photocopies are acceptable.)
- Two letters of reference. (Family is not eligible to be a reference). Include name and contact information.
