- 2. One-page **cover letter** written by the student explaining education goals and your future plan in the agriculture industry
- 3. **Resume** (or a list of involvement/accomplishments)
- 4. **Evidence of enrollment** in your course of study. This can be a scanned/digitally photographed copy to provide electronically.
  - o If entering college/university, a copy of your acceptance letter
  - If already enrolled in college/university, a copy to show most recent course enrollment
- 5. **Letter of recommendation** (from a mentor, employer, volunteer organization leader, etc.) that outlines your personal involvement in the industry and community, and your role as a current and/or future leader in agriculture.

Bursary winners will have their names & photos published in OFA promotional materials.

Bursary winners may have the opportunity to receive their bursary in person at OFA's

Annual Meeting and Convention, in Hamilton Ontario, November 2019.
