Dear Ms. Lennon:

I know this is a challenging year for all of us. I want to commend everyone who has taken efforts to ensure they and their workers are safe on their farms and share information for you and your members on programs that may help you in those efforts. It takes all of us working together to control and prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Last month, we announced a new agreement between Ontario and the federal government which will see Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada invest an additional \$11.6 million to help support efforts by Ontario producers to reduce the spread of COVID-19 on farms.

This investment will expand the province's Enhanced Agri-Food Workplace Protection program which provides support for farmers and other operations to assist with preventative occupational health and safety measures. With help from this investment from the federal government, we have doubled the amount farmers can claim for preventative expenses, to \$15,000.

We have also introduced the On-Farm Worker Safety Improvement Program which will provide support of up to \$100,000 for small capital projects including housing modifications, workplace modifications and equipment to allow greater physical distancing for workers.
