To all to whom these Presents shall Come
Greeting

Whereas *The Corporations Act, 1953 provides that with the exceptions therein mentioned the Lieutenant-Governor may in his discretion, by Letters Patent, issue a Charter to any number of persons, not less than three, of twenty-one or more years of age, who apply therefor, constituting them and any others who become shareholders or members of the corporation thereby created a corporation for any of the objects to which the authority of the Legislature extends;*

And Whereas *by the said Act it is further provided that the Provincial Secretary may in his discretion and under the Seal of his office have, use, exercise and enjoy any power, right or authority conferred by the said Act on the Lieutenant-Governor;*

And Whereas *by their Application in that behalf the persons herein named have applied for the issue of a Charter constituting them a corporation for the due carrying out of the undertaking hereinafter set forth;*

And Whereas *it has been made to appear that the said persons have complied with the conditions precedent to the issue of the desired Charter and that the said undertaking is within the scope of the said Act;*

Now Therefore Know Ye *that under the authority of the hereinbefore in part recited Act I do by these Letters Patent issue a Charter to the Persons hereinafter named that is to say:*

Lloyd George Jasper, of the Township of Carrick, in the County of Bruce and Province of Ontario, Farmer; Gordon William Greer, of the Township of Nepean, in the County of Carleton and Province of Ontario, Farmer; and John Andrew Ferguson, of the Township of Southwold, in the County of Elgin and Province of Ontario, Farmer; constituting them and any others who become members of the Corporation hereby created a corporation without share capital under the name of

ONTARIO FEDERATION OF AGRICULTURE

for the following objects, that is to say:

- (a) TO co-ordinate the efforts of the different branches of agriculture throughout Ontario for the purpose of promoting their common interest through collective action, and to act as the Ontario unit of the Canadian Federation of Agriculture;
- (b) TO render such services to those engaged in agricultural pursuits as conditions may justify;
- (c) TO assist in formulating and promoting provincial, national and international agricultural policies to meet changing national and international economic conditions;
- (d) For the objects aforesaid, to collaborate and/or negotiate with other organizations, whether incorporated or not, within or outside Ontario;
- (e) For the objects aforesaid, to carry on printing and publishing and to sell and distribute literature;
- (f) TO receive, acquire and hold gifts, donations, devises and bequests; and
- (g) TO take or otherwise acquire and hold shares and securities in any other corporation having objects altogether or in part similar to those of the Corporation or carrying on any business capable of being

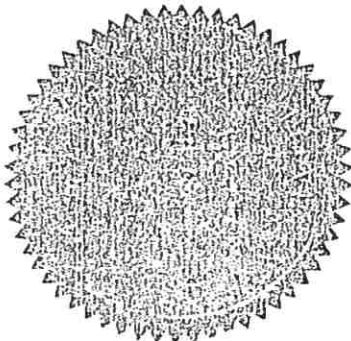
conducted so as to benefit the Corporation;

THE HEAD OFFICE of the Corporation to be situate at the City of Toronto, in the County of York and Province of Ontario; and

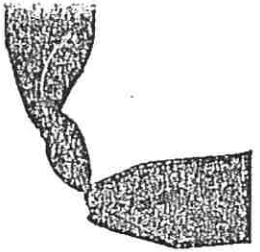
THE FIRST DIRECTORS of the Corporation to be Lloyd George Jasper, Gordon William Greer and John Andrew Ferguson, hereinbefore mentioned;

AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND DECLARED that the Corporation shall be carried on without the purpose of gain for its members and any profits or other accretions to the Corporation shall be used in promoting its objects.
