I farm in the hills between St. George and Glen Morris, at the north end of Brant County, where I grow corn, soybeans, wheat, hay, and edible beans, alongside a herd of 25 beef cows. I practice no-till farming and plant green to protect the soil on my hills and to keep the stones where they belong.

Over the years, I've been actively involved in the agricultural community, having served as President of the Brant

Federation from 2011 to 2013 and as a member of Brant's Ag Advisory Council during its first three years.

I am also a Director for the Brant Cattlemen's and have represented the Golden Horseshoe region as a regional director for OSCIA, where I proudly served as President in 2023.

If chosen as Zone 3 Director, my primary concerns would be road safety for farm equipment, truck safeties for low-kilometre farm vehicles, and addressing sandhill crane crop damage before it becomes devastating. I'm always trying new things on the farm and am open to innovation, but I also believe we shouldn't discard the hard-earned knowledge of previous generations.

I would love the opportunity to serve the region to the best of my abilities but sometimes family and the farm must come first.
