

Hello everyone my name is Clint Cameron, OFA director, proudly serving our membership across Zone 11 (Dundas, Frontenac, Leeds & Grenville) and currently seeking your support for another term.

My background is well rooted in rural life and agriculture. I grew up on a hobby farm north of Prescott and when I was ten my parents took the opportunity to upgrade our soil and location to where we now farm north of Cardinal. From the mid 70s until today our farm lifestyle and footprint has evolved to meet the needs of market changes and customer demands. We went from a farm focused on competitive Quarter Horses and thousands of small square bales a year to 'briefly beef' and today crop hay, grains and raise spotted and dappled Boer goats which we sell across Canada.



While always connected to the farm and supporting my parents I attended the University of Ottawa where I studied Criminology and Admin Management, then went to Queens for Finance. From an off the farm career perspective, I've worked in procurement, logistics, wet corn milling, project management, finance and global programs. So, for about 25 years I essentially worked a few different jobs but my heart was always the farm, the animals and the land. In 2016 I was fortunate enough to full time return to my passion and grow that future for both me and my family.

Three years ago, I was approached and encouraged to run for the Zone 11 director position by previous and current directors. I'm very pleased that happened because I believe my life skills and experience has made a difference in representing and supporting the OFA and rural communities, not only in zone 11 but across the province. In this time I have done multiple radio interviews, news paper contributions, OFA viewpoints, guest speaker engagements, political/civic round table discussions, invited to join the Port of Johnstown Advisory Board, held multiply advocacy discussion with politicians at all 3 levels of government & with their staff, been to Queens Park, The Senate and the House of Commons. I also chair the OFA finance committee, am past chair of the Energy committee and sit on the pension governance committee. I believe I have a solid foundation to work from but there is still more to do and there are new head winds facing agriculture and our rural communities.

My high-level focus going forward continues to be & will be:

- Land use preservation for agriculture / food sovereignty and sustainable development.
- Investments in rural infrastructure and agricultural support programs essential for our province.
- Conservation authority restructuring and ensuring Ontario agriculture is represented.
- Labour shortages and the maintenance of a temporary foreign workers program for agriculture.
- The biggest unknown effecting eastern ON and that is the ALTO proposal. I've been involved with this topic since our first-round table call with them in 2025 and proud of Dundas for moving the resolution recently unanimously approved by the OFA board to formally oppose the current corridor alignment.

Serving on the OFA board and representing you, our business's, and our way of life isn't the easiest challenge I've ever tackled but I do passionately believe in our mission and our future. I glad I came to it with decades of life experience, sweat equity in my family farm and the humility to know there is still lots to learn.
